Guidance on hanging paintings in the library

As a general guide you may bring four small paintings, or three medium paintings, or two large ones. "Small" means roughly A4 size, "medium" means roughly A3 size, and "large" means roughly A2 size. **Please remember that the display space is limited and that our library hanging team may not be able to accept larger paintings if members bring more entries than we can accommodate.**

All paintings must be ready to hang and comply with the same requirements as those for our exhibitions:

- Each painting must have a label on the back giving Name & Contact Details, Title of Painting, Medium and Price
- Glazed paintings must be completely sealed and the glass must be clean and free from sticky labels.
- All frames must be fitted with **D rings (NOT screw eyes)** and **taut cord or wire (NOT cotton string)**.
- Clip frames are not permitted.
